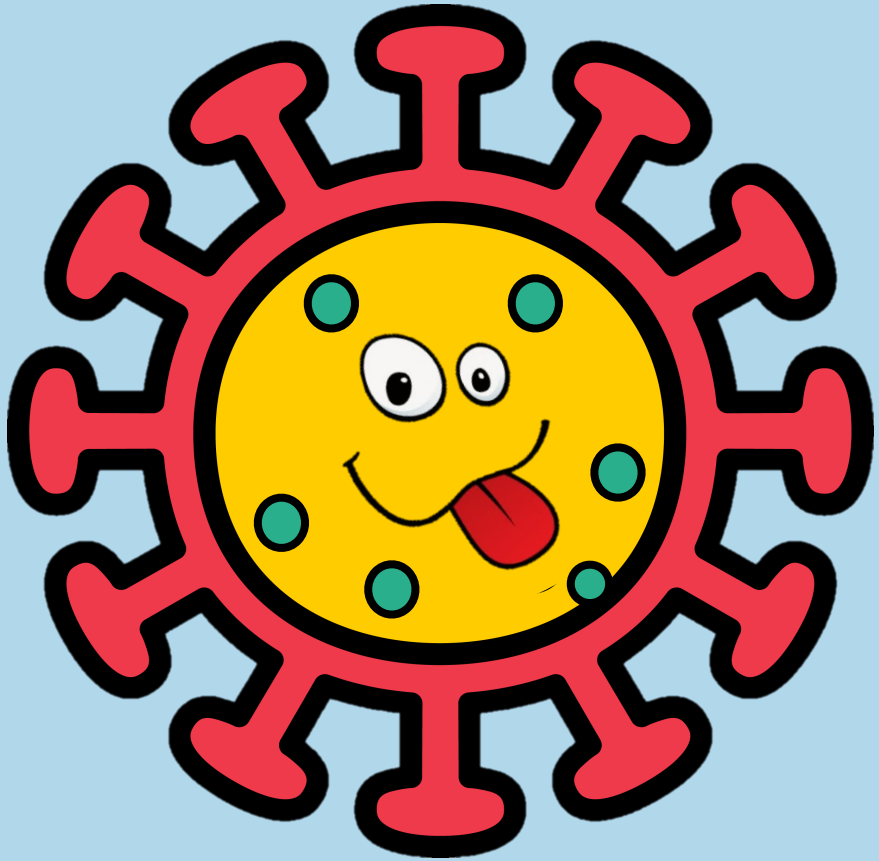


# Welcome Back!

of Coronavirus.

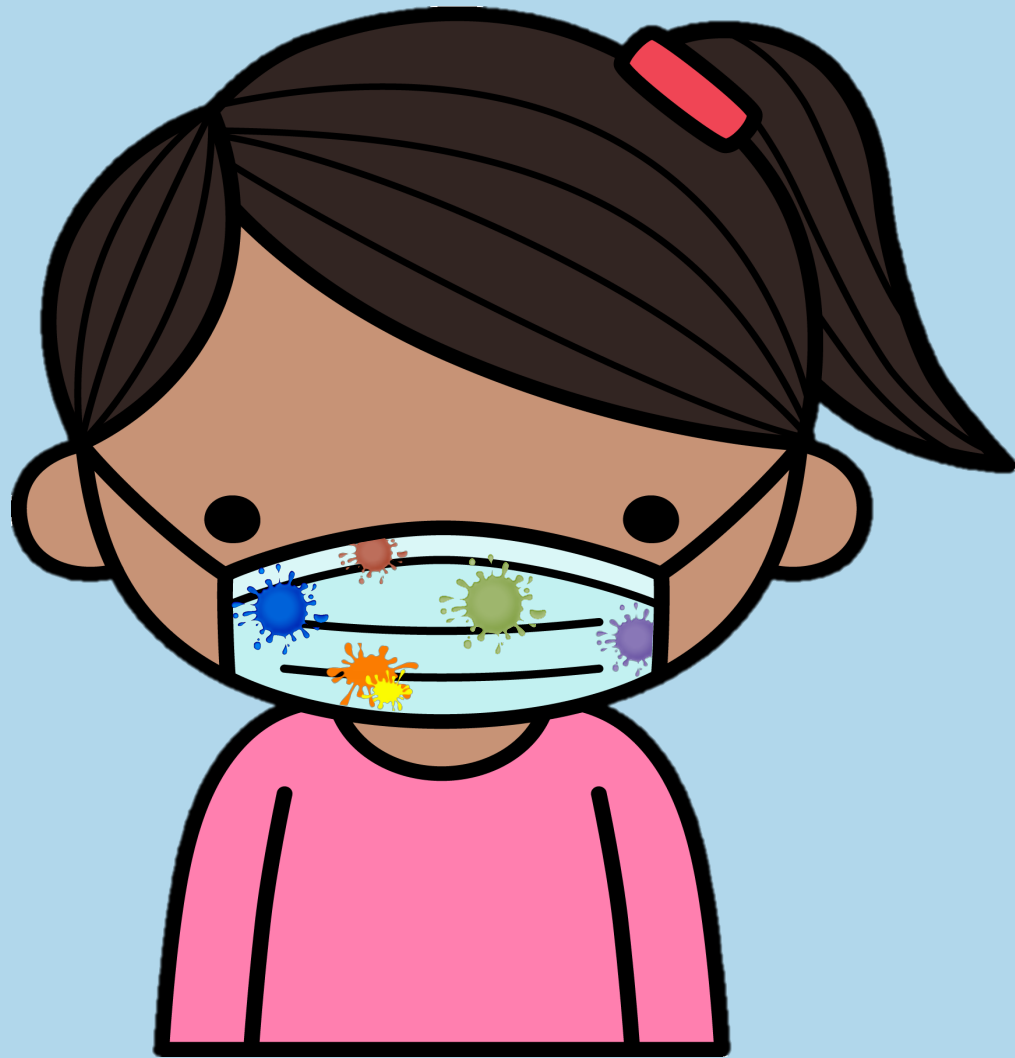
I am so happy my

use to it

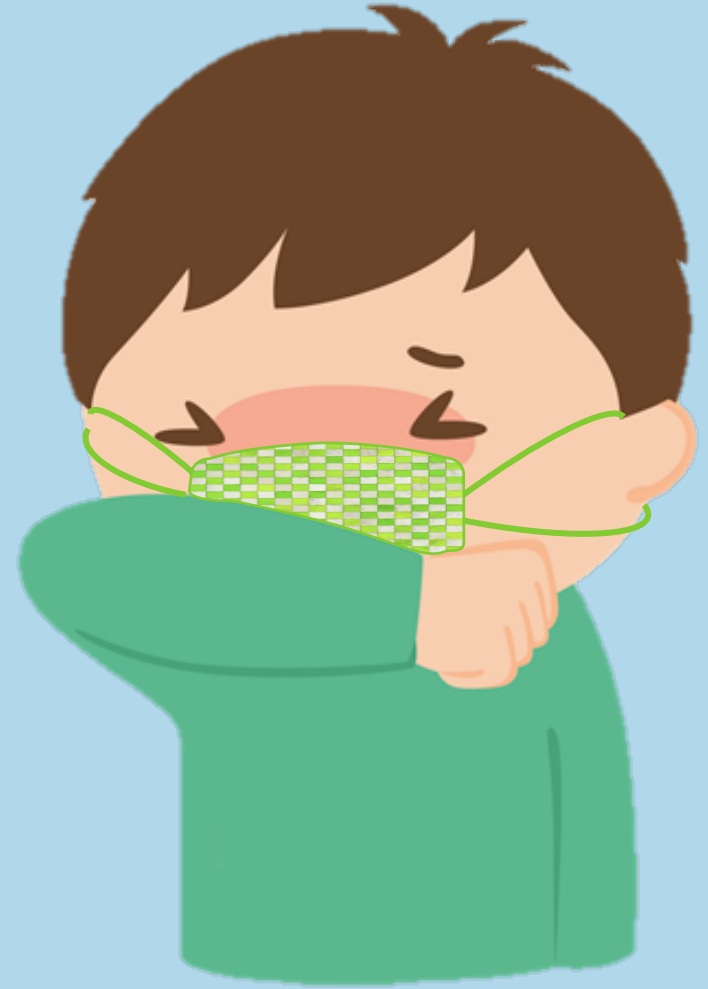
I may have my temperature

cough into my elbow.



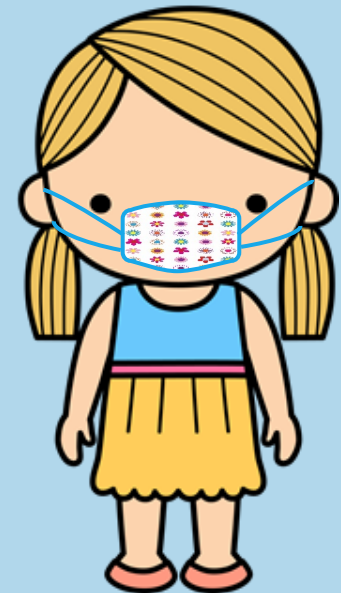
I should not touch my face
