Simone Gauthier spoke before the Grant Committee. Some of the highlights were:
211 is the recognized number to contact Infoline in CT
There are over 42,000 services available to residents within CT
Groton Senior Center was recognized for its value as far as transporting seniors to Dr's. appt. and shopping, banking, etc.
There were over 40,000 calls to 211 from residents and businesses in Southeastern CT last year
Infoline will provide current information on grants and foundations that will provide money to agencies. The amounts range from a few hundred dollars and up.

Gary Lehrman reported that they are working with Melissa Marshall to facilitate the Sensitivity Awareness Training Program for town employees. Information was distributed to all committee members present for their information.

Topics to be covered will also include ADA Law. She will be responsible for the training for the department heads, the management team, the RTM and Town Council.

Mary Hannigan briefly spoke concerning the recent meeting with the Town department heads. They were supportive of the grant and questions concerning the grant application and the process were answered. It was also decided that the Town would participate in Disabilities Mentoring Day on October 15. Department heads or representatives from each department would serve as a mentor for students enrolled at Fitch that day. Details will be worked out when school resumes in August. Mary Hannigan spoke with Chris Gaynor concerning the distribution of money to pay for the grant programs. The possibility of doing reimbursement over direct payment needs to be worked out during phase 1 of this program.
