



Implementing an Intervention Block

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Introduction of the problem

- Large number of referrals to special education and/or referrals due to lack of other choices
- Lack in number of interventions available
- Lack of efficacy of the interventions that are currently available

Vision / Mission

- Student achievement, teacher confidence and competence, and the SRBI process will improve from implementing the intervention block.
- We will create a system of interventions for students at risk of failing in order to provide specific instruction to improve their achievement.

Outcome

- Increased student achievement and reduction in referrals to both SRBI and Special Education, as well as a decrease in the number of students in sustained SRBI.

What has been achieved thus far:

- Piloting the intervention block for quarter 4 has been designed
- Students have been selected and assigned to teachers
- Teachers have been briefed on the students by the liasons from the Student Assistance Team (SAT)
- Goals have been set and data collection methods have been established for each student
- Goals have been communicated to the teachers working with each student

Next steps

- Pilot will begin 4/3/2023
- Evaluation of the efficacy of the block will be completed by 6/3/2023.
- If the intervention block is deemed successful, it will be reimplemented at the beginning of the 2023-2024 school year.
